## **Laurentian University: New Dress Code for the Animal Care Facility**

Effective: October 1, 2007

Clean solid shoes (not sandals)

Clean Lab coats or other approved apparel to be worn in the facility are not to be worn outside of the facility. Lab Coats can be stored in the entry closet. It would be advisable to have your name on the coat. Please do not wear the visitor or staff lab coats unless you are a visitor or staff. It is the responsibility of all people who are performing research with animals to provide their own lab coats and to keep them clean.

The ACC recommends that facility approved gloves be routinely worn in the animal holding rooms and hands should be washed after handling.

A facility approved mask is required when entering animal holding rooms or emptying or cleaning bedding. Any possible allergy symptoms should be immediately reported to staff.

Please inform staff if you have handled other rodents outside of the facility on the day of entry.

Please note the following items which are not allowed due to the possible disturbance to our animal residents:

- Food or drinks
- Loud noises or talking loudly

The ACC supports an odor-free environment in the Animal Care Facility.

There are some posted rooms which have more stringent dress code requirements. Please do not enter any rooms other than the ones you have been assigned without permission from a staff person.
