Description	<p>Insight Grants support research excellence in the social sciences and humanities. Funding is available to both emerging and established scholars for long-term research initiatives of three to five years.</p> <p>Stable support for long-term research initiatives is central to advancing knowledge. It enables scholars to address complex issues pertaining to individuals and societies, and to further our collective understanding.</p> <p>The Insight Grants funding opportunity supports research proposed by scholars and judged worthy of funding by their peers and/or other experts. Insight Grants research initiatives may be undertaken by an individual researcher or a team of researchers working in collaboration.</p>

Insight Development Grant

Duration	1 to 2 years
Application deadline	February 2017
Results announced	Spring-Summer 2017
Description	<p>Insight Development Grants support research in its initial stages. The grants enable the development of new research questions, as well as experimentation with new methods, theoretical approaches and/or ideas. Funding is provided for short-term research development projects, of up to two years, proposed by individuals or teams.</p> <p>Within the Insight Development Grants funding opportunity, funding is available for two distinct categories of scholars: established and emerging. For the current competition, at least 50 per cent of funds will be reserved for applications from emerging scholars.</p>

Connection Grant

Value	\$7,000 to \$25,000 for events, and up to \$50,000 for other outreach activities; higher amounts for outreach activities may be considered if well justified
Duration	1 year
Application deadline	February 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1
Results announced	At the end of each funding cycle (March, June, September and December)
Description	Connection Grants support workshops, colloquiums, conferences, forums, summer institutes or other events or outreach activities.
